REV 4/04/21

- Effective April 6th, Delaware eligibility will be age 16 years and older.

The state waiting list will open at 10am on April 6 at vaccinerequest.delaware.gov. Pharmacies may begin vaccinating everyone who is 16 and older on April 6 (please note: pharmacy waiting lists are separate from the state waiting list)

Summary of who is still eligible to get the vaccine right now through 4/6/21

- Persons 50+ years of age or older
- Health care personnel
- Long-term care staff or resident
- Persons 16 – 64 with high or moderate-risk health conditions
- Frontline essential and other essential workers including educators or school staff, child care worker, first responders, food service, construction, transportation (those with greatest risk based on inability to work from home, frequency of contact with public, age and underlying health factors will be eligible sooner)
- Anyone eligible in previous phases or groups who has not yet received a vaccine.

Though you are eligible now, it may still take a few weeks to make a vaccination appointment based on the size of this group.

The Pfizer vaccine is authorized for persons 16 and up. The Moderna and Janssen (Johnson and Johnson) vaccines are authorized for persons age 18 and up.
